Mega Cities

Very big cities with more than ten million inhabitants are also known as mega cities. There are mega cities all over the world - except for Australia – and they are still growing. New York, Mexico City, New Delhi or Tokyo, - the biggest city - are some of them.

Today more than half of the world population live in cities – and it will be even more in the future: The United Nations say that by 2030 three out of five people (around five Mio) will live in cities.

In every mega city people have to deal with a lot of problems such as waste, air pollution (also known as "smog") and water pollution, traffic jams and accidents caused by too many cars.

In the poorer quarters of the cities (often called "slums" or "favelas") people don't have access to clean water or electricity; Moreover life is very dangerous because there are many crimes. Drug dealing and violence by street gangs are some of the problems.

Solutions for these problems are hard to find: Cities need to invest in public transport (trains or subways) and renewable energy sources (such as wind and solar power) to reduce air pollution. For people with low incomes the city has to provide affordable* flats and houses.
